Hello Church Family!

We've got some fun and exciting news... we are REARRANGING! And we've been dying to share the plans!

Countryside Covenant has always valued our Christian Formation hour on Sunday mornings. We use this hour for both adults and students to grow in their knowledge of the Bible and build community within the body of believers. More and more, we have noticed some hiccups with the placement of classrooms, flow of traffic and safety of our kiddos. Lots of suggestions were discussed amongst the Staff. We took the time to invite a Covenant building use specialist to discuss our church facility and classroom options. He loved our space and he believes we can be more efficient in our use of our classrooms and floorplan.

The Staff have come up with some fresh classroom configurations that will allow us to rearrange, redecorate, and implement by the Fall 2024 Christian Formation year. These changes will affect almost all of the classrooms only during the Christian Formation hour on Sunday mornings. Wednesday evening classroom use will stay pretty much the same.







Over the remainder of the summer, you may notice an increase in painting, furniture rearranging and relabeling of hallways or classrooms. As a church staff, we believe this change will allow us to better steward the incredible facility we have been blessed with, as well as create even more space for growth!

During our remodel, we would encourage you to check with the Church Office before using any of the classrooms, even for a one-time, ad hoc meeting. Reserving a space ahead of time will ensure that you have something suitable to your needs that avoids our construction zone.

We are thankful for you, our church family and this exciting new "rearranging adventure." We hope this plan will be a breath of fresh air come Fall and allow more and more opportunities for growth and service!

These studies are offered with absolutely no homework necessary so, just grab your Bible and show up on that particular **Wednesday at 7 pm** in **Room 18.**


Opportunities

GREAT WEEK OF VBS!

During the first week of June, we had about 150 kids join us for our summer VBS! It was a fantastic week learning about the *Rock Solid Truth* of God! Our highlight for the week was our offering project. The kids gave it their all as they raised money for the bridge-building projects in the Congo through the Paul Carlson Partnership. They raised over \$2000 in coins plus we had a \$1000 match. And thanks to your additional giving on VBS Sunday we came in at around \$5000. The leadership team also utilized FAITH funds to match that with another \$5000. This brought our total to \$10,000! This is enough to fund an entire bridge in the Congo!

CHANGES TO FALL MINISTRY


Leadership Team

It is officially summertime! We welcome the changing seasons that God brings us, to show us He is at work in our changing seasons of life. Our Leadership Team has been at work as well. In this month's meeting we again reviewed our financial status, as we do every month, and were pleased to know that we are a little under budget as of May. Our income for June far exceeds our income for last year on this date! Thank you church family for giving back to serve God's kingdom in the ways that He provides for and blesses you! That has been one of our goals as a the Church Leadership Team, to pour back God's blessings from our Faith Funds!

In that, we, as a church were able to be a blessing and fund the remainder of the entire amount left after the donations of VBS, and our Sunday, June 16th, collection for the bridge project in DR Congo! That is \$10,000.00 collected for the entire bridge project! We were also able to fulfill a request for funds for the Pregnancy Service Center to grant them an additional \$1,000.00. Omega Houses, here in our community, are in need, and an additional \$3,000.00 was granted to them. We also saw fit to give \$1,000.00 to JAARS – Jungle Aviation and Radio Service, who's mission is to reduce barriers, ease burdens and deliver God's Word to remote jungle communities, as they provide Bibles in translations for those communities, as well as aviation support, land and maritime transportation, information technology and media. Look for them to visit in July at our McPherson airport for information and helicopter rides!

Continue, friends, brothers and sisters in Christ to bless and transform lives for Christ and please, even in these summer months... let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another – and all the more as you see the Day approaching.
