Worship Team Audition Packet
Countryside Covenant Church

We are excited about your interest in serving on the Worship Teams here at Countryside Covenant Church! We are glad to see that you are taking a step forward to explore how God might use you in the Worship Arts Ministry at Countryside. To help you understand the audition process, please read this packet with the following information.

Everyone

First and foremost, **we are not looking for perfect people or perfect musicians**. We understand that no one is completed; we are all growing in Jesus and in our talents. Please do not be intimidated by this process. This process is designed to give us as much information on your current maturity and ability so that we can put you in opportunities to succeed and grow. This process is <u>not</u> designed for the purpose of weeding out inferior musicians. Please contact our Worship Arts Director if you have any questions or concerns about the process. We are hoping you will audition!

We ask that anyone auditioning be an active attender at Countryside Covenant Church. We believe that in order to lead the congregation in worship, the leaders need to be in community with our body of believers. If you do not yet meet this requirement, please contact our Worship Arts Director to schedule an audition at a later date. We also require that you be at least 16 years old. If you do not meet this age requirement, please contact our Worship Arts Director for information on how to get involved with Children or Student Worship Teams.

Vocalists

If you are auditioning as a vocalist, we ask that you prepare a solo of some kind. It can be any religious song that you choose. This will be sung acapella (without backing instruments or tracks) on the melody line. Also, please prepare to sing harmony parts to these four songs:

- 1. How Great Thou Art (by Paul Baloche, on YouTube)
- 2. Stand in Your Love (by Bethel, on YouTube)
- 3. Great is Thy Faithfulness (by The Worship Circle, on YouTube)
- 4. His Mercy is More (by Shane and Shane, on YouTube)

The music for these songs is attached at the end of this document. We primarily utilize chord charts through a service called MultiTracks.com. If you are uncertain on how to play from chord charts, please contact our Worship Arts Director ahead of your audition for guidance. Again, please prepare a harmony **(non-melody part)** to sing for each song. You will be asked to harmonize with Connor singing melody and playing piano or guitar for each of these songs. You will be singing through a microphone.

Instrumentalists

If you are auditioning as an instrumentalist, you will be asked to play your chosen instrument on these four songs:

- 1. How Great Thou Art (by Paul Baloche, on YouTube)
- 2. Stand in Your Love (by Bethel, on YouTube)
- 3. Great is Thy Faithfulness (by The Worship Circle, on YouTube)
- 4. His Mercy is More (by Shane and Shane, on YouTube)

The music for these songs is attached at the end of this document. We primarily utilize chord charts through a service called MultiTracks.com. If you are uncertain on how to play from chord charts, please contact our Worship Arts Director ahead of your audition for guidance. You will be playing through the sound system, and will play alongside Backing Tracks (aka MP3s) and a Click Track with these songs. It is recommended that instrumentalists play their parts as closely to what is heard on the recording as possible.

Everyone

As well as preparing these musical selections, you will also be asked to answer the following questions verbally at the time of the audition:

- Describe your salvation experience. What are you doing to further your walk with Christ?
- Describe what you believe to be your spiritual gifts. What are some additional skills or talents you have outside of music? What are you passionate about?
- Are you involved in any other ministry groups at Countryside Covenant Church or within the community?
- Why do you want to be a part of the Worship Team?
- Define worship. Why do we sing as a part of worship?

Please try to keep your answers brief and to the point. Each person is given 20 minutes for their entire audition, so please keep that in mind as you prepare your answers.

Please understand that no one, whether you are a current Worship Team member or auditioning, is guaranteed a spot on the Worship Teams. The desire for our Worship Team is to find musicians that fit with our unique style and blend of worship. If you are not chosen for the Worship Team, please understand that there are other places for you to serve in the Worship Arts Ministry or in other ministry areas at Countryside. The Worship Team is simply one area of this church comprised of a select number of musicians that fit our current style of music.

Current Rehearsal Time and Preparation Commitments

By auditioning for Worship Team, you are making a commitment to the Worship Ministry at Countryside Covenant Church. As a part of the commitment, you will be expected to attend all rehearsals the week you are scheduled to serve.

The current rehearsal and service schedule consists of the following:

- Thursday evening rehearsal from 7:00-8:45pm
- Sunday morning rehearsal 7:30-8:00am
- Both Sunday morning services at 8:30am and 11:00am

Songs selections will be sent out by the Tuesday before our Thursday rehearsal. It is expected that you will practice the music in-depth prior to Thursday's rehearsal. Thursday rehearsal should not be the first time you are playing/singing the music for the week.

Please understand that anyone who is scheduled to play or sing for a service is expected to be at all rehearsals and to come prepared. If a conflict arises after scheduled, it is expected that you notify Connor ASAP so that replacement arrangements can be made.

Any other special services during the week or at different times will be by availability, and those rehearsal details will be sent out at the appropriate times.

As mentioned previously, all worship team members are expected to be active participants in the Body at Countryside. This means, at minimum, attending church on Sundays that you are not serving on Worship Team. We must be a part of the Body to minister with the Body.

Please prayerfully consider the time and energy commitment involved with Worship Teams. By auditioning, you are committing to these requirements.


